	with several species of garter snake, salamander and frogs as well as		
	mammals such as black bear and black-tailed deer.		
Other Features	To the south, views of the Cascade Mountains including Mount Cheam ar		
	sweeping views of the farmland of the Eastern Fraser Valley. In winter,		
	views open up to the north of the Fraser River.
