Bio:

Ron Long is a professional photographer. He had a thirty six year career as the sciences photographer at Simon Fraser University. During that time he picked up a great deal of biology and photographing nature is his greatest interest.

Since retiring in 2004 Ron travels to photograph in nature hotspots around the world. His trips have taken him to China, Australia, Southern Africa (7 times), South America (12 times) and numerous visits to the American southwest (pre trump).

Ron's talk on photographing nature brings together the experience gained in a lifetime of photography. Included are discussions of equipment and techniques that he has found to work well and ways to approach wildlife for frame-filling photographs.
